Because the ARIAS•U.S. Code of Conduct (the Code™) sets forth considerations and behavioral standards only for arbitrators, the questions in this course will address only the conduct of arbitrators. Nevertheless, it is expected that the parties and their counsel will conform their own behavior to the Canons and will avoid placing arbitrators in a position where they are unable to sit or are otherwise at risk of contravening the Canons. Some of the behavior and actions of the non-arbitrator participants in the fact pattern used for this Ethics Course may fail to meet this standard, and you should not assume that such behavior and actions are sanctioned or approved by ARIAS•U.S.

It is also the case that this course has as its primary objective to educate by applying certain hypotheticals that are designed to implicate sections of the Code, as noted. Neither the hypotheticals nor the responses are intended to be utilized for any other purpose, as even minor changes to hypotheticals can lead to debatable changes in results and/or distinct sections of the Code being implicated.
